BananaSigatoka
diseaseThere is a chance of sigatoka disease in banana during rainy season. As a
prophylactic measure, proper drainage facilities have to be ensured and
spray 20 gram of pseudomonas per one liter of water during non rainy
period.CoconutLeaf blightYellowish brown spots with grey brown margins appear on leaflets causing
extensive leaf blight. Remove the severely affected older leaves and burn it.

CoconditElear orightSpray the crown with Bordeaux mixture 1% or Propiconazole 25 EC 2
ml/L.LivestockKeep the cattle shed and premises clean to avoid mosquito breeding. Avoid water logging near
the cattle shed. The cow dung pit can be covered to protect from direct falling of rain.
