GENERAL ADVISORY	To prevent dehydration, drink plenty of water at regular intervals. With increased evaporation and persistent dry atmospheric conditions, ensure timely irrigation for crops and maintain adequate soil moisture levels.				

AGRO-METEOROLOGICAL ADVISORIES

Paddy	Rice bug	To control rice bug in paddy, spray fish jaggery extract (20 ml/lt) or neem seed kernel extract (50 gram/lt). Keep the field and bunds free of weeds and grasses.	
Banana	Magnesium deficiency	Apply magnesium sulphate 30 g/plant in bands near plants. Application of dolomite reduce deficiency in long run.	
Chilli	Powdery mildew	Spray wettable sulphur 80 WP 2 gm/lt or carbendazim 50 WP 2 gm/lt	
Cattle	Provide plenty of drinking water to cattle. Avoid grazing in the peak hours of the day. Provide fan and proper ventilation in the shed
